

From the Leadership Board of Redeemer Lutheran Church:

The Leadership Board met Wednesday May 27, 2009. Staff members presented their reports and a variety of topics were discussed. Pastor Roper noted that on June 7th nine new members were to be received and that new pew Bibles had been ordered. Craig Britton advised the board that June 28th was selected as the "Outdoor Movie Night" and August 9th was to be the date of the "Carnival", we also discussed a number of his other concerns. Deb Fall made note that during the services on Sept 6 & 13, Oct 4 & 11, Nov 1 & 8, and Dec 6 & 13th the new Lutheran Service Books were to be introduced, also of some note the Rev. James Keat will be at the pulpit July 5th and the Rev. John Rathje will be here July 12th.

The Treasurer, Linda Kline, delivered her report. We were in the black for April \$2,000, but YTD we are still in the red \$14,000. Please pray that the financial situation continues to improve. The Call Committee reported that all documents requested by District had been sent, we are now waiting for them to get back with us. The Audit Committee presented their report, everything is in order, and the report will be presented to the congregation at the June 14th voters meeting.

The responsibilities and authority of the Communications Team were discussed; it was decided that all communications to the congregation and to the "outside" would be run through the Communications Team. This was thought to be the most efficient and clear method to deliver our mission.

Next month we will be discussing a spending approval policy, the Call process status, and supporting other ministries that are not reporting directly to the staff or Leadership Board. Come one, come all.
